

Clay's Corner

An interesting thing happened to me while Mary and I were visiting Brodhead, Wisconsin two weeks ago. It was one of those moments in life that cannot be explained except that God is at work and He will use those who willingly allow Him to do so to accomplish His purposes.

In the history of the early church (Acts 17:16-34), Luke records an interesting story about a visit the apostle Paul made to a place called Mars Hill in Athens. There (in summary) Paul addresses a group of men who are interested in this "new" religion he has been preaching. And he does so in a very unique, unobtrusive manner.

Seeing all the statues around him, he notices one, entitled, "the unknown god" and uses that statue to tell those who had gathered to listen the story of the God of Creation. And he does so without being offensive. Basically what he says is this: "I see you have a statue here without a name. Let me tell you who this God is." And he goes on from there to explain Jehovah and His ways and ends with the resurrection of Christ. In just a few verses Paul explains who God is and introduces just enough information to strike the curiosity of many, which prompts them to ask him to speak to them again on the subject of the resurrection.

No bashing. No controversy. No heated debates. Just simple information spoken in a nonobtrusive way with the goal of further discourse at a later time. Easy as pie. And the story ends with some scoffing but many desiring to hear more.

Back to Brodhead, Wisconsin: I finally met a man who I have known via Facebook for over a year. He and his grandson were on their way to a private place to "read scripture". As they walked away I had a nagging feeling that I should join them. I almost didn't go. But something kept moving me in their direction. So I quick stepped over to where they had just sat down to read and asked if I could join. "You know I am a minister. Do you mind if I sit in while you read from the scriptures?" To which my friend answered, "We don't mind, but you probably won't want to listen as we will be reading from the book of Mormon."

Oops. What now? I know many who would have walked away. I know many who would have condemned and debated. But I did what I was called to do; witness the power of the resurrected Savior to those who will listen. And that is what I did. I sat in silence as the words were read and I waited. And when the opportunity presented itself I shared the message of Christ in the same manner Paul did that day long ago on Mars Hill. Without offense.

Results? I don't know. I may never know. But I planted seed. And I shared the love. And two people who were used to hearing about how wrong they were from others, looked at a minister of the "real" gospel of Jesus Christ with a sense of curiosity which one day may cause them to ask further questions. And as I walked away I heard the words, "Thank you."

My dad used to tell me, "You can catch more flies with honey than you can with vinegar." Well played dad! Well played.
