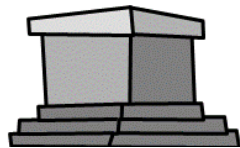

Clay's Corner

Habakkuk 3:16-19 I heard and my inward parts trembled, At the sound my lips quivered. Decay enters my bones, And in my place I tremble. Because I must wait quietly for the day of distress, For the people to arise who will invade us. Though the fig tree should not blossom And there be no fruit on the vines, Though the yield of the olive should fail And the fields produce no food, Though the flock should be cut off from the fold And there be no cattle in the stalls, Yet I will exult in the Lord, will rejoice in the God of my salvation. The Lord God is my strength, And He has made my feet like hinds' feet, And makes me walk on my high places.

Good morning everyone. God Bless you this day and everyday. May His countenance shine upon you. And may He make your paths straight.

As I do most days, I am perusing the news and reading up on the events of overnight. And were it not for the places in scripture where the men of old remind us that God is in control, I think I might just crawl under my rock and quit.

Habakkuk had seen in his dreams what God had in store for Israel because she had become so wicked. And it frightened him greatly. The people had strayed very far from God and now God was going to let them reap the harvest of their sins; another, more wicked nation was going to overrun and conquer Israel. It was almost more than the prophet could bear. And so it goes with all who turn their back on the Lord. America is no exception.

I've heard from a lot of people who claim to know that we are living in the end times because of all the wickedness and violence in our country. Just for example, the senseless murder of a deputy in Harris county, Texas Friday night and then the senseless death last night in Portsmouth, Virginia of a mentally impaired man, jailed 4 months ago for the petty theft of a candy bar and a coke from a 7-11, valued at less than 5 dollars.

Our system of government is broken. Period. And no one seems to understand why. I do. Self righteousness. Apathy. Idolatry. And immorality are rampant. SIN.

Habakkuk knew and he had seen what God had in store for a nation in similar depravity as ours. Are these the ends times? I don't know. Personally, I am not too concerned either. I was. But I am not anymore. I will do what I can by sharing the message of salvation and being what I profess to be, but God is in control. Whether he sends Jesus for the final coming or He sends a conquering nation to destroy our own, I will rejoice in the Lord for He knows what He is doing, even when I don't.
