## Clay's Corner

As I mentioned last week, we have decided to break with tradition and release the Church in Gonzales from the confines of the box that has limited our growth. One way we intend to do this is by changing the Sunday evening format. We will not be meeting together on Sunday evenings for a second worship service.

Here is a brief overview of what we will do each Sunday in lieu of a second worship period in the evenings:

1st Sunday of the month: Family Oriented—may include small groups, family studies, meals together, or family time

2nd Sunday of the month: Youth Oriented—bowling, state parks, outing to someone's house, etc.

3rd Sunday of the month: Family Oriented—may include small groups, family studies, meals together, or family time
