Clay's Corner

"For by the grace given to me I say to every one among you not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think with sober judgment, each according to the measure of faith that God has assigned. For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, in proportion to our faith; if service, in our serving; the one who teaches, in his teaching; the one who exhorts, in his exhortation; the one who contributes, in generosity; the one who leads, with zeal; the one who does acts of mercy, with cheerfulness." – Paul to the Roman Christians, chapter 12, verses 3-8.

January 3rd marked the first Sunday in the year of our Lord, 2016. Once again, we find ourselves turning the page of history to start a new year. Many will have made New Year's resolutions. Others, having difficulty keeping the previous year's promises will not have made any for this year. Whatever your situation is, it is important to remember a few things as we continue in our quest to be the called out people of God. Of all the things I wish for us to do this year, one of the most important is that we change the way we think of the word "church".

That's something a lot of faithful never realize, those who have strayed or have lost their way, when they left, took with them their talents. As such, we all have become handicapped of sorts because of the vacancy others leave behind when they walk away. Once we see that, I think it becomes easier to desire to have them back. You see it's not just about numbers. It's about resources, talents, gifts, it's about family. And each member is important to the wellbeing of the church. Each person, no matter where they are in life are valuable to God and important to Christ's body.

So when they come, and they will come, be sure to not only make them feel welcome, but make them feel needed and wanted also.
