"You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven; for He causes His sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous. For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? If you greet only your brothers, what more are you doing than others? Do not even the Gentiles do the same? Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect." - Matthew 5:43-48

In life, there are basically two definitions of what it means to be human. There is the worldly definition and there is God's definition. The two are not the same, not even close.

As Christians, one of the things we profess that separates us from the world is this: We have allowed God to define who we are as humans.

But have we really done that? What is it that really separates us from and defines us differently than those without God? I propose to you with tears in my heart that many who claim to be God's children are not, for they do not act any different than those around them; they do not think any differently than those who are lost.

I suggest to you today, if we are to accomplish our goals to be more like Christ, we need to seriously reconsider what we have chosen to define who we are.

Several times throughout scripture we see God say this: "...for My ways are not your ways..." And while that is certainly true, we are called to be Christ-like in all that we are. Is it possible? Can our ways be like God's ways? Can we think like Him? Act like Him? Should we even try?

Paul put it this way in Ephesians 5:1-2, "Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God."

Be imitators of God, as beloved children. Powerful words, Easy to say, Not so easy to do unless we completely surrender to Him.
