



Clay's Corner

"And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ, so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes. Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love." - Eph. 4:11-16

I know a lot of preachers who will not say the things that need to be said because they are afraid of being fired. If you haven't figured this out by now, I am not one of those preachers. I listen to what is said. I will take advice and suggestions from anyone and everyone on what to preach about or what to teach about, but at the end of the day, I will answer to the Lord for my actions and not to anyone else. As such, I preach on and teach on the things the Lord lays on my heart.

I said that to say this, on Wednesday evenings we are looking at, studying, preparing and equipping the saints in Gonzales for service in the Kingdom of God. We are developing, and will develop, a vision for our congregation as we live and work among the lost in our community and we will also develop a purpose statement as a means of both defining our purpose and quick and easy remembrance of our purpose in this community. We are looking to and working towards a brighter day for the Church of Christ in Gonzales, Texas.

In light of the events this week in our nation I am stepping up the push to set the goals for our congregation. I can think of no better or more opportune time for the people who calls themselves sons and daughters of the most high God to be about the Lord's business. And I am calling on you, my brothers and sisters in Christ to cast your lot with us on Wednesday evenings as we look for new and better ways to get involved in His purposes.

Paul said in his letter to the church in Ephesus that God didn't just create a church but he gave to His creation certain men with specific gifts, not so that those men could fill all the various roles the church plays in the community in which it exists, but so that the individuals who make up the church would be equipped to do "their ministry" in the world around them.

Paul said that God gave gifts to certain men in order to equip the saints for the work of the ministry. For far too long we have hired "preachers" not to equip the congregation for ministry but to do the work of the ministry of the whole church. It should be evident to all the results of that history. It's time to step up and be who we claim to be. It's time to step up and do your ministry. I can't do it for you. I won't do it for you. I will help equip you to the best of my ability. But I cannot, nor will I, do what you have been called to do.

Jesus told it like it is. Paul never minced words. I won't either. It's time. Choose this day whom you will serve.
