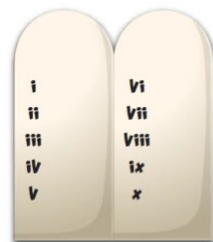

# Are you back in the presence of God?

Do you have those people in your life that will tell you the same stories over and over again? Each time is like the first time they are telling it. I love those stories because those stories mean that much to that person and they're sharing it with you. I have been lucky enough to have experienced those in my life. My father told me a story of when he was in the Navy about being called to the Captain's office. This scared him and he was trying to think what he did that the Captain would need to talk to him. He goes and the Captain says he heard my father had a bowling league and the Captain wanted to play. This is one of those situations where you could wonder, first I can't say no to the Captain, second why would he want to be on our team? Why would a guy in such a high position be on a team of nobodies underneath him on a ship? I don't know about you but that is often my reaction when I read the stories about God wanting to be in relationship with us. Why would someone with so much power want to be so close to the things he created of which most don't want to have anything to do with Him? The answer is so simple it's hard to comprehend. He loves us! He's invested in us! As we have been seeing, God has been trying to get back to the relationship He had with mankind in the garden.

God takes another step forward with that in the story of tabernacles in the desert. The tabernacle is seen as a tented palace for the Divine King. He is enthroned on the ark of the covenant in the innermost Holy of Holies (the Most Holy Place). His royalty is symbolized by the purple of the curtains and his divinity by the blue. The closer items are to the Holy of Holies, the more valuable are the metals (bronze, silver, gold) of which they are made. The other symbolic dimension is Eden. The tabernacle, like the garden of Eden, is where God dwells, and various details of the tabernacle suggest it is a mini-Eden. God in The Story chapter 5 gives Moses blueprints to build a place for Him to dwell with His people.

God has taken steps along His entire story to be in relationship with us. God has completed the process of being in relationship with us. You might argue that and say I'm not in heaven or a garden worshiping Him all day long, being in His presence how could I say that. As Christians we are given the best gift. That gift is talked about in one of my favorite verses. Acts 2:38 "Peter replied, Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit" (NIV). God by giving us His spirit to dwell within us puts us back into complete relationship with Him through the death, burial and resurrection of His son Jesus Christ.

**Challenge:** I challenge you to live like you are back in the garden with God. That will look different for every person. See if that makes a difference in some daily situations of life. Live like the spirit of God in dwelling in you like he was in the tabernacle of the wanderers Israelites. It could be acting out fruit of the spirit. Focus on reflecting that in my relationship with my family or friends or brethren, even a stranger at the store in gentleness. Not being too quick to judge. Instead of allowing anger to well up inside, give God a chance to tame the temper.
