You are God's representative to all people

What is it that people represent? We, of course, have the obvious answers. We represent ourselves, families, and business. Soon, talks about what people represent will heat up more inside of our government. With a presidential election coming up, people will be doing a lot of talking about what they represent. In the government, being a representative means to work on behalf of your constituents to make fair and just laws, balance the budget, and choose judicial appointments wisely. In business, a representative works to showcase a company's products or services to potential buyers or clients.

Christians should understand that we represent what we're preaching and teaching. It has been said and will continue to be said that our actions show more of what we represent than do our words. It is true, and that's what we're seeing with those who claim to be people of God in The Story chapter 10.

The Tabernacle, the movable place of praise for God's people, was set up at Shiloh and was meant to be a clear picture of God's holiness and grace. A system of sacrifices had been established that foreshadowed the coming sacrifice of the Messiah. Yet, anything but holiness was found there. Eli, the priest, had two sons, Hophni and Phinehas, who dishonored God in their treatment of the sacrifices and also engaged in activity with women at the Tabernacle (1 Samuel 2:16, 22).

The representation of God they were giving was not what it was supposed to be. These two were killed in battle against the Philistines. When news of their death reached Eli, he fell over in his chair, broke his neck, and also died.

Eli and his sons were representatives of God to the people and the world. We represent Jesus to others. We are a part of a royal priesthood (1 Peter 2:9). Authenticity and transparency are far more important than just our words. We like to think we are perfect representatives, but we need the grace of God just as much as the rest of the world. We may need it even more since we claim to know what is right and what is wrong. Knowing right from wrong is a responsibility of ours so we can be lights for Christ. It is becoming increasingly true that we may be the only Bible those around us will ever read. The question we must all answer is the question, "How are we representing God, Christ, and His plan?

This week use some avenue available to you to represent Christ. This can be by leading, or even following. Do it at work or at home, by being thankful for service given to you or by serving. In any or all of the situations be images of God in your action and speech.
