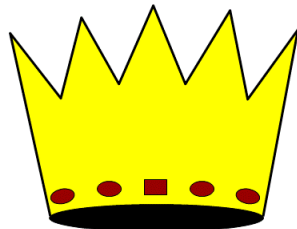

The Time is Always Now

One of my least favorite statements that I seem to always utter is “I’ll do it in a minute”. That is a go to phrase for me with practically anyone. Meaning of that phrase can vary, “I’m busy with something else”, “I need to think about if I really want to do it”, or “I won’t do it and I’ll just let you forget about it”. This is a problem that isn’t very good, because the more you do it the habit of putting things off come into play. Even the habit of mis-prioritized things come into play when you aren’t always focused accomplishing first things first.

This may seem silly, but being in the habit of kicking the can down the road can have extreme effects in life and priorities. It did for the Israelites and still does for us today. When we make our things and priorities over what God has laid out for us it affects our daily lives in one way or another. The Israelites learned that lesson the hard way. They returned from Babylonian captivity to rebuild the temple. They started strong but in time turned their attention to other endeavors. What was important to God became unimportant to them. Sixteen years passed without any work being done on the temple. So God allowed drought and downturns and difficulties to come upon them. And he said, “Give careful thought to your ways” (Haggai 1:5, 7).

They had their priorities mixed up and the goal of glorifying God with everything we do got placed down on the list. God is either the main thing in your life or he is nothing. At the end of the day, each of us are responsible for our own schedule. There is really no such thing as partial obedience. God begins as the priority and then we schedule time with him. We schedule the things that are important to him. Jesus said, “Seek first the kingdom of God . . .” (Matthew 6:33).

Our things, decisions, with everything need to revolve around the question how can I glorify God with this? This week I gave my daughter a dollar and asked how can you use this keeping in mind making God happy needs to be the goal. Her answers were pretty good. How will you answer that question this week with all decisions you make? If we don’t think about it or say it, we will never do it.
